Location, location! The location of their lemonade stand might make the difference between your youth meeting or exceeding their goal. The Site Selection lesson will help youth determine the perfect location for their stand. They will want to choose a safe place with lots of thirsty customers that have money to buy their lemonade!







Here are some discussion topics and questions you can ask your youth to reinforce the Site Selection lesson.

## **Discussion:**

- Discuss the location of other businesses in your community and why their owners may have selected these particular spots.
- Take your youth on a field trip around your community to scout possible locations and discuss the pros and cons of each one.

## **Questions:**

- 1. What are the characteristics of a good location?
- 2. Will you need to ask for permission to set up at a particular location? If so, who will you need to ask?
- 3. Is the location safe? Will potential customers pass by?
- 4. If people will be driving to your location, are there places for them to park?
- 5. Based on the pros and cons, where would the perfect location be for your lemonade stand?
